Learning Outcomes and Competences	In designing, the combination of imagination, trained vision and understanding of space is a decisive advantage. While studying, drawing is a process of intensive learning of spatial vision. As such, drawing represents training in precisely the aforementioned critical components for an outstanding design. The project takes place as a week-long course in Berlin (winter semester) or in Teterow, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern (summer semester). The diversity of the urban landscape, nature and wildlife, offers participants a rich reservoir of ideas used as a starting point for drawing and painting compositions. Educational goals are applying the knowledge and skills acquired in basic studies to a dissimilar task; developing an understanding of image and colour composition; and training the confident handling of drawing materials and techniques. The drawing skills gained in the project form the framework for a completely free, individual artistic expression. Living and working in a common space, the daily evaluation within the group and the collective exhibition promote team spirit and improve discussion abilities.
