<b>Learning Outcomes and Competences</b>	<p>Incoming design students experience Berlin with different eyes. In this blended-learning course former viewing habits and new impressions are transferred to creative pattern cutting.</p> <p>Draping is an essential skill for fashion designers. It is the art of using cotton muslin or other fabrics to create a fashion design directly on a mannequin. This method will be used to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- develop different shapes</li> <li>- learn about proportion and fit</li> <li>- bring together creativity and construction skills in one step</li> <li>- explore the limits of the physically possible and technically feasible</li> <li>- recognize the effect of different materials to the garment shape</li> <li>- see which effect different cutting directions have to the material</li> </ul> <p>The students learn about cut specific processing techniques and material manipulations. They train their sense of proportion, body shapes and processing abilities and understand the pattern specific connection of three-dimensional form and two dimensional pattern / fabric in an intuitive way.</p> <p>The participants learn to organize their work and prepare themselves independently by using course specific online contents on the Moodle platform.</p> <p>A semester model (pattern and toile) will be marked.</p>
